### Indigita launches new online training on Introduction to Digital Assets

Geneva, 23 August 2022 - Swiss regtech company Indigita SA has launched a new e-Learning course on cryptocurrencies and tokens for banking executives, relationship managers and compliance officers. The new e-Learning covers the main concepts and definitions of digital assets and provides an overview of the regulatory framework.

The new online course provides a comprehensive introduction to digital assets and how they work from an operational and banking compliance perspective, including regulatory aspects, tax compliance and liabilities for financial institutions.

The course also contains two intermediary quizzes - to assess the comprehension of the different chapters - and ends with practical cases to evaluate the behaviour of a banker interacting with prospects active in the field of digital assets.
